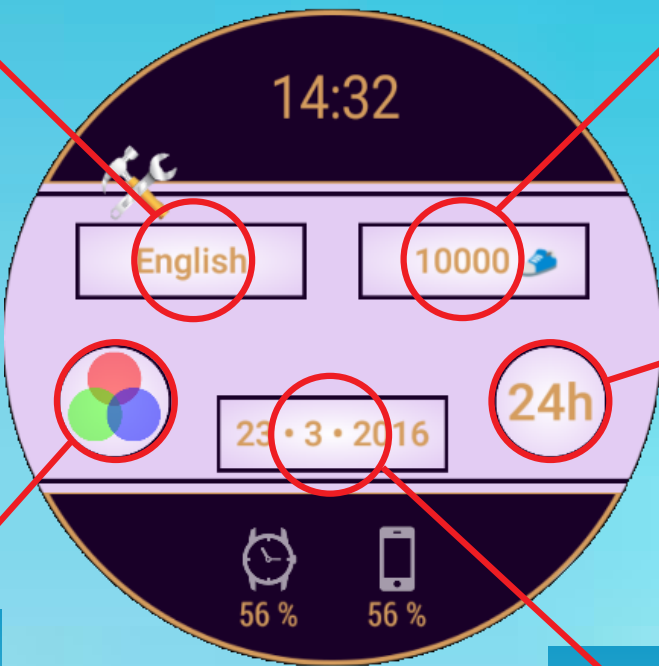

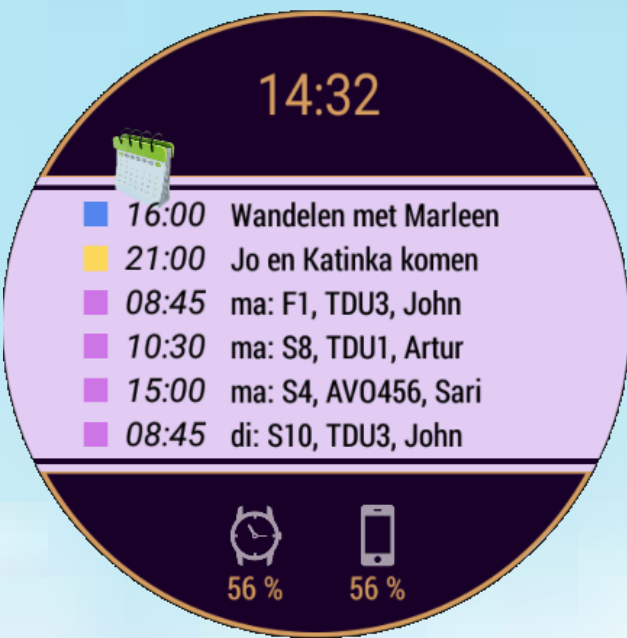

The daily steps goal is set to 10,000 by default. However, it can be set to any custom goal, between 1,000 and 20,000, using the settings menu (see former page).

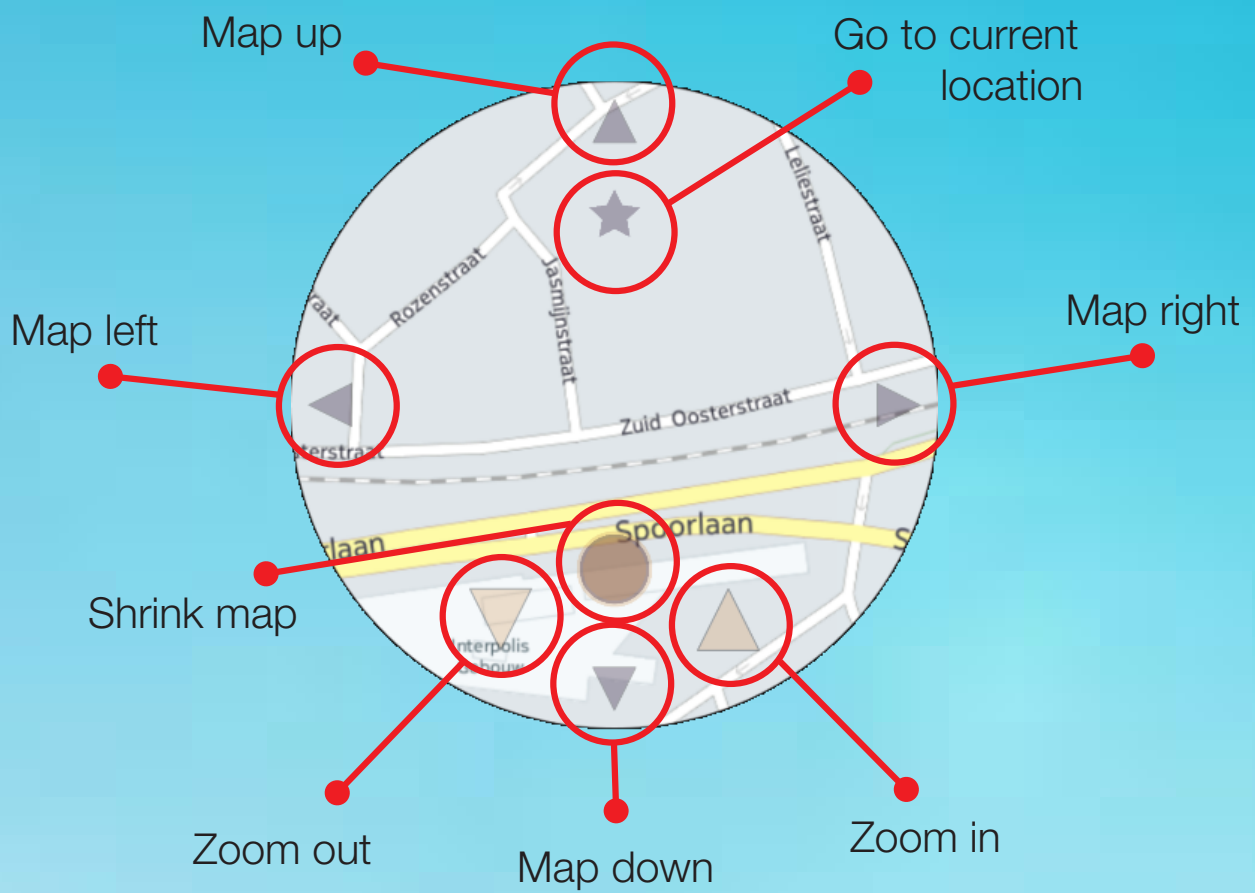

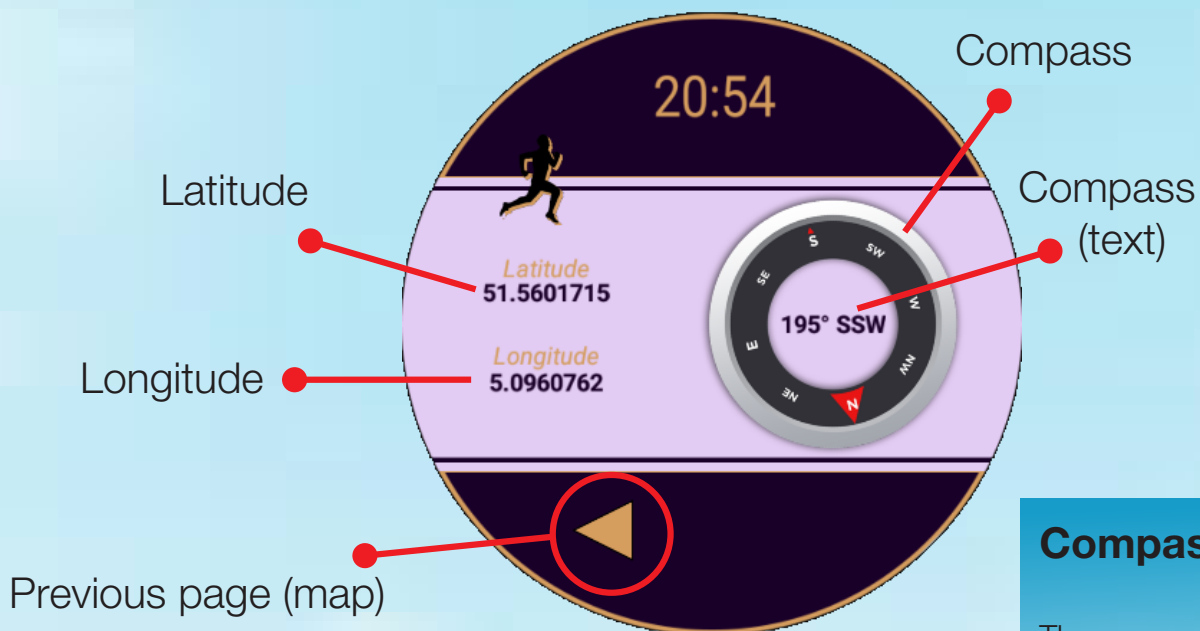

The compass will only work on watches that offer support for it. The LG R watch is such a watch. The Huawei watch unfortunately isn't.

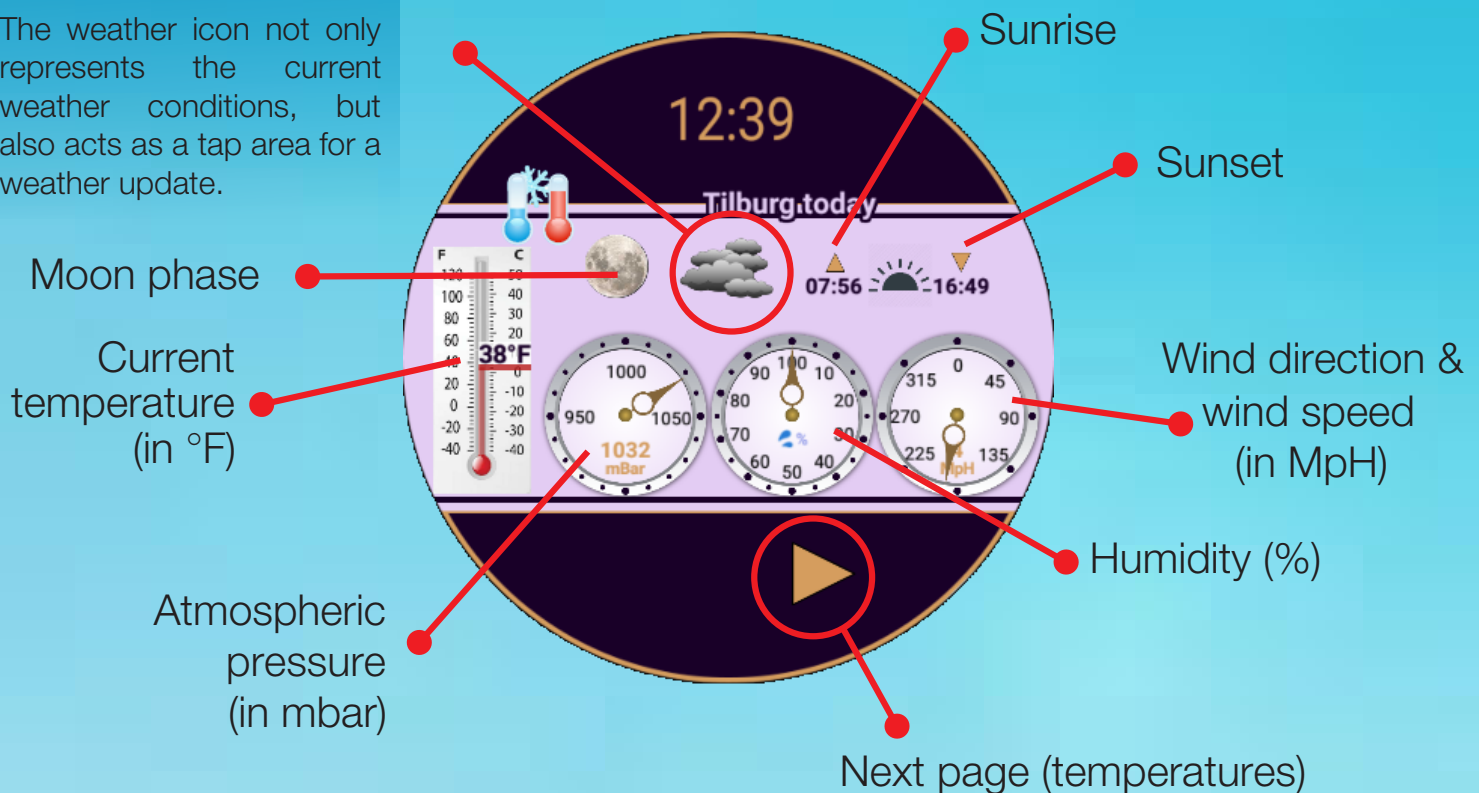

Weather icon

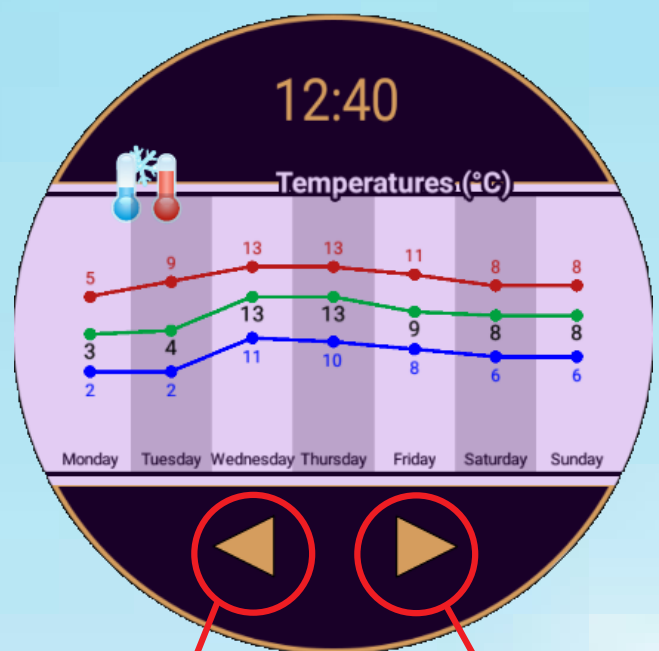
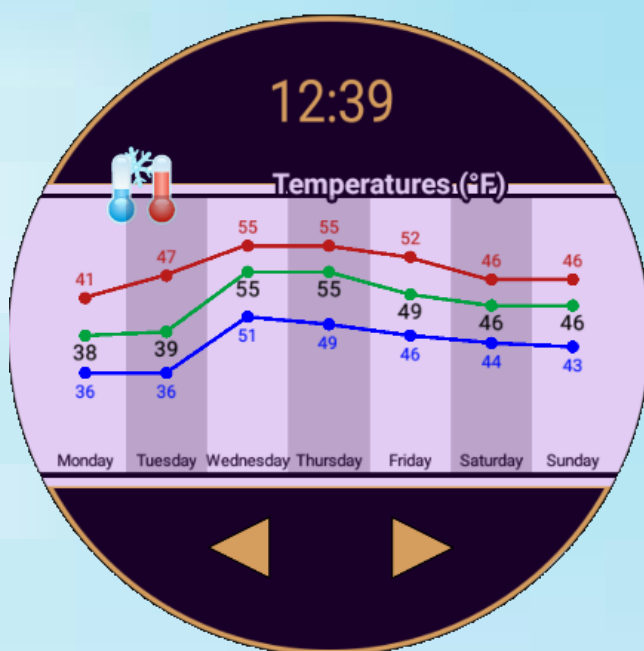
The weather icon not only represents the current weather conditions, but also acts as a tap area for a weather update.

Fahrenheit or Celcius

Sprie Digitotal can display the temperatures both in Fahrenheit and in Celcius, as well as the speed both in MpH and in km/h. However, this depends on the settings in WatchMaker.

Go to the main menu in WatchMaker, choose Settings → Weather → Temperature scale. From here, you can either set Fahrenheit or Celcius. The dimensions for speed will be adjusted accordingly.

Help! My watch doesn't display the correct weather information!

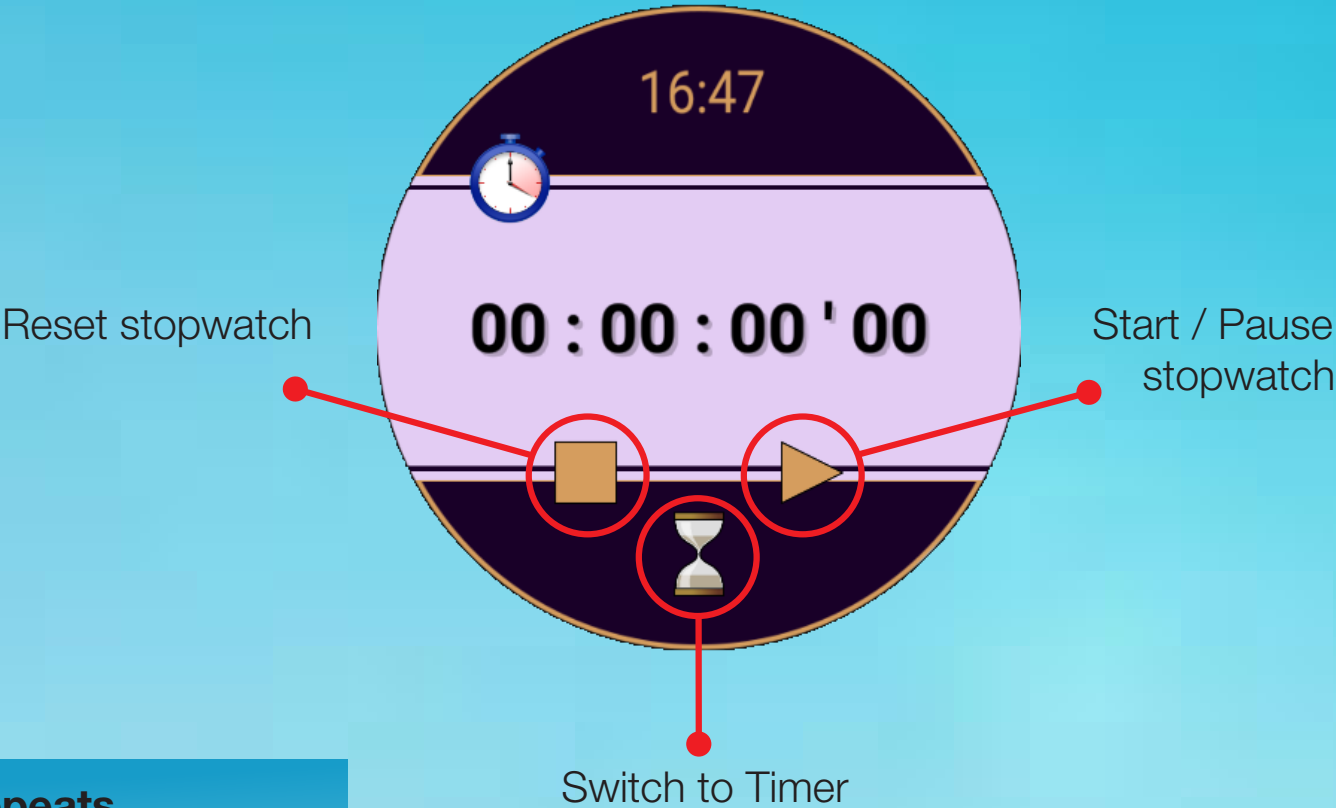
If your watch shows wrong temperatures, or even no temperatures at all, for example, it may be worth trying another weather provider.

Go to the main menu in WatchMaker, choose Settings → Weather → Weather Provider. From here, you can select one of the other two weather providers.

Stopwatch

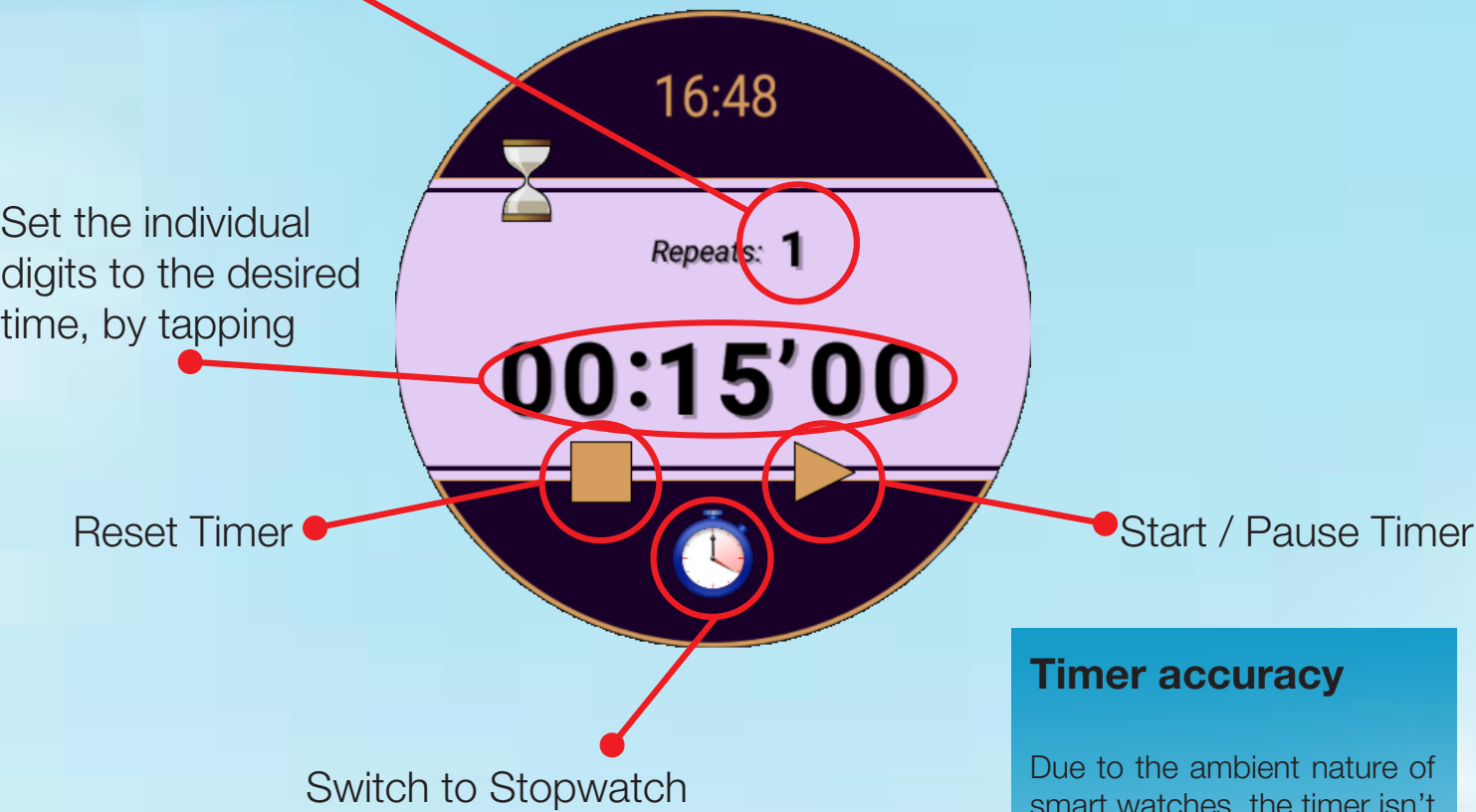

Count down timer



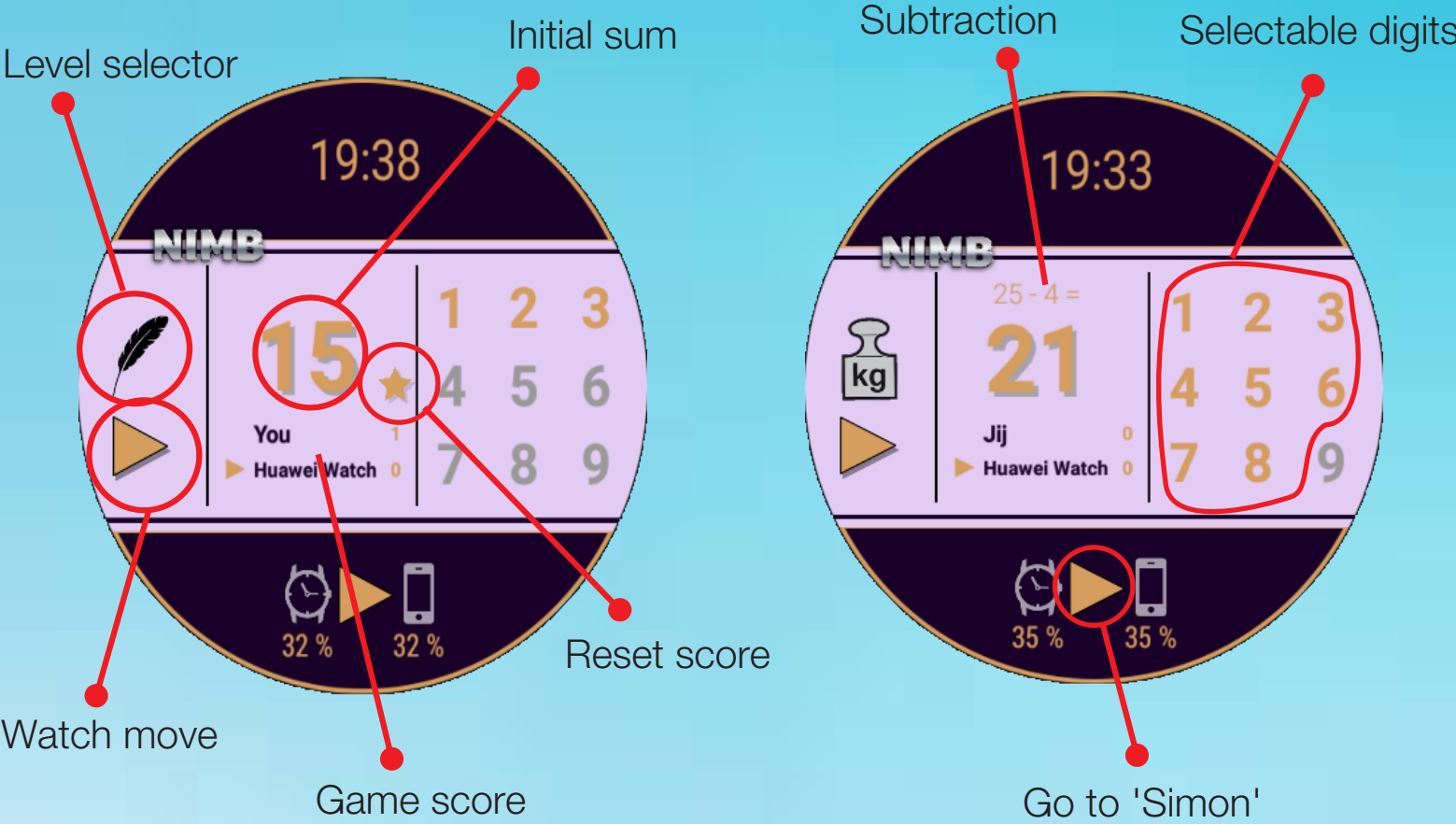
Timer accuracy

Due to the ambient nature of smart watches, the timer isn't very accurate. Although the timer keeps running in ambient mode, the alarm will only vibrate at the minutely update. So, for critical chemical reactions or similar cooking times, the built in Google timer is the better choice.

GAMES *

Nimb



The game of Nimb

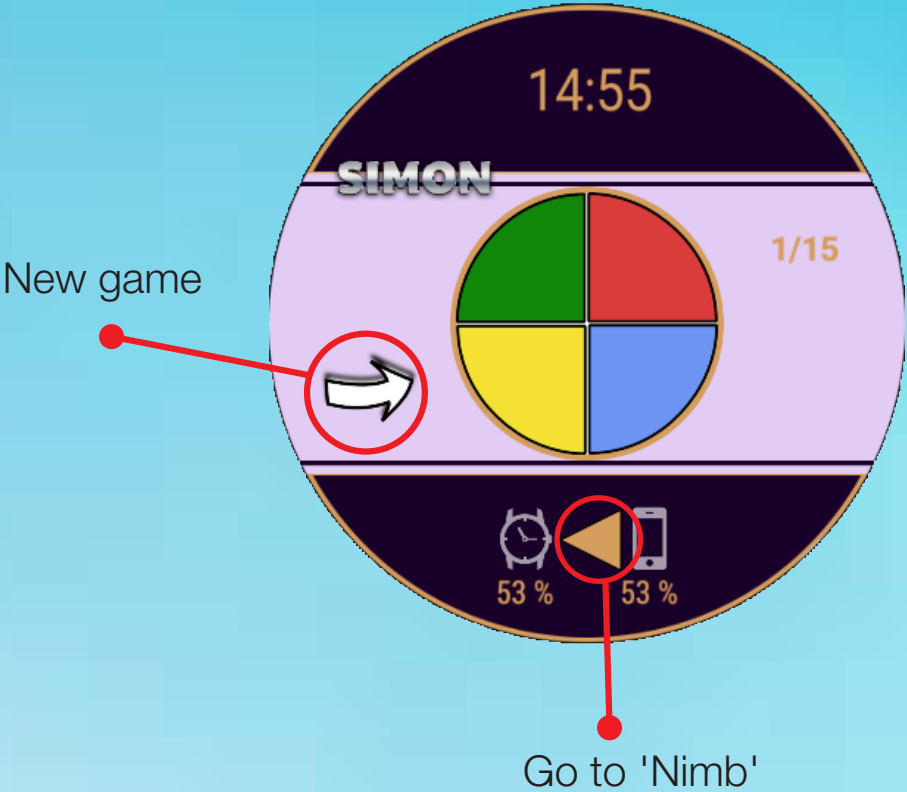
Nimb is a subtraction game. Alternately, you and your watch subtract a number of an initial sum. The one who subtracts the last digit (1) will loose.

There are two levels. The easy level (feather) starts at 15, while only 1, 2, or 3 can be subtracted. The hard level (weight) starts at a random number between 15 and 99, while a random number of digits between 3 and 9 can be subtracted.

The player who starts first, is chosen at random. The score can be reset after each game by pressing the star.

Simon



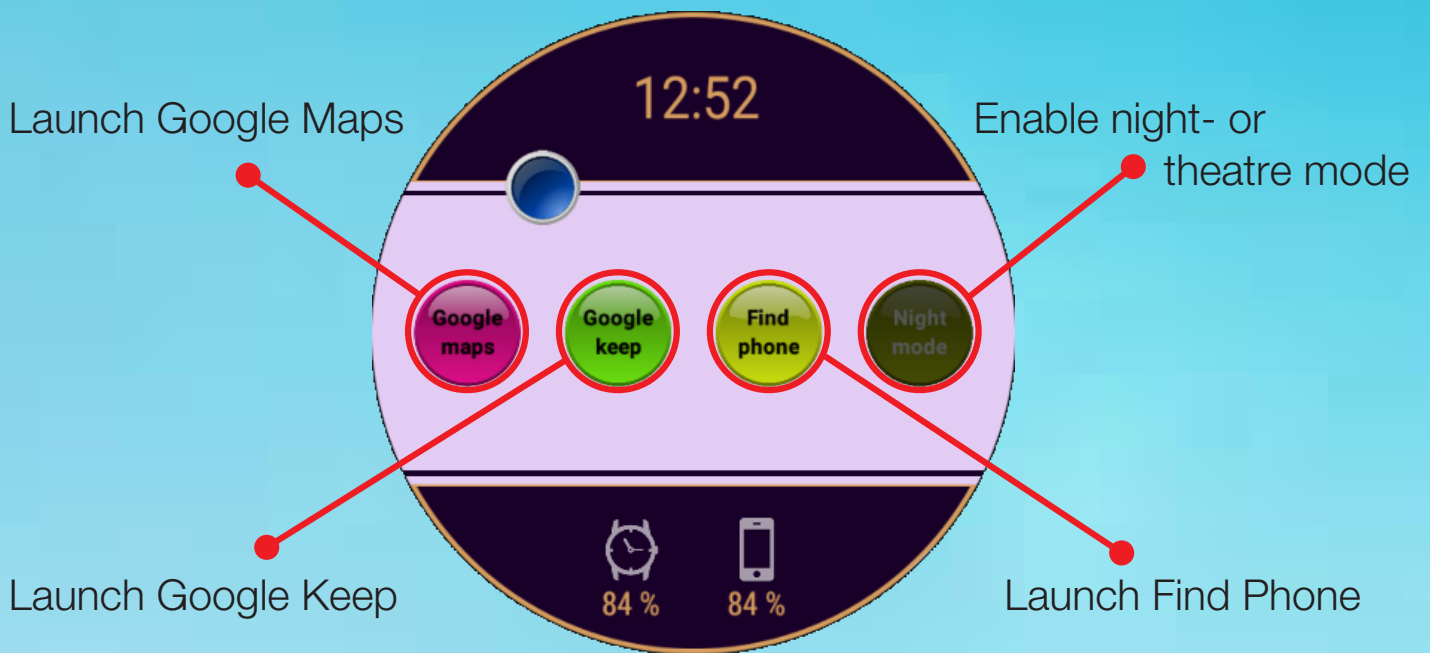
The game of Simon

Simon is a well-known memory game. Your watch will subsequently lighten up a number of coloured sections, after which you'll have to press the same sections, in the same order. After every successful attempt, the watch will add a new section to the original order.

One, two or three sections probably won't cause any trouble, but the game can get very challenging at 8, or 9, or 10 subsequent sections. Will you be able to remember the order of 15 different sections?

LAUNCHER *



The launcher page

The launcher page lets you fire up three built in apps that can be found in every smart watch: Google Maps, Google Keep and the handy utility Find Your Phone.

Tapping Night Mode will put a dark layer over the entire screen, which is useful at night, but also in the theatre or cinema. Although you will still be able to read the time, your watch screen won't disturb other people.

WatchMaker

WatchMaker is written by Alex Curran, and offers a large number of tools and features for creating your own watch faces – even in minutes! Especially the built in Lua interpreter extends the possibilities to nearly infinite. But even without programming, you can design really impressive watchfaces with lots of functions. The WatchMaker community at Google+ is huge (over 150,000 members!) and very helpful, while the internet offers excellent wiki's and tutorials.

WatchMaker Premium is not free, but it's worth every penny. Moreover, it gives access to literally thousands and thousands of free faces, found on websites such as www.facerepo.com and www.watchawear.com. WatchMaker is highly recommended!
